

subscribe to various architecture magazines and blogs to keep myself informed about the latest happenings in the industry. Additionally, I am a member of a few architecture forums online where we discuss and share the latest trends and technologies. Whenever I come across something new and interesting, I try to see how it can be incorporated in my work to enhance the design and efficiency of the projects.


