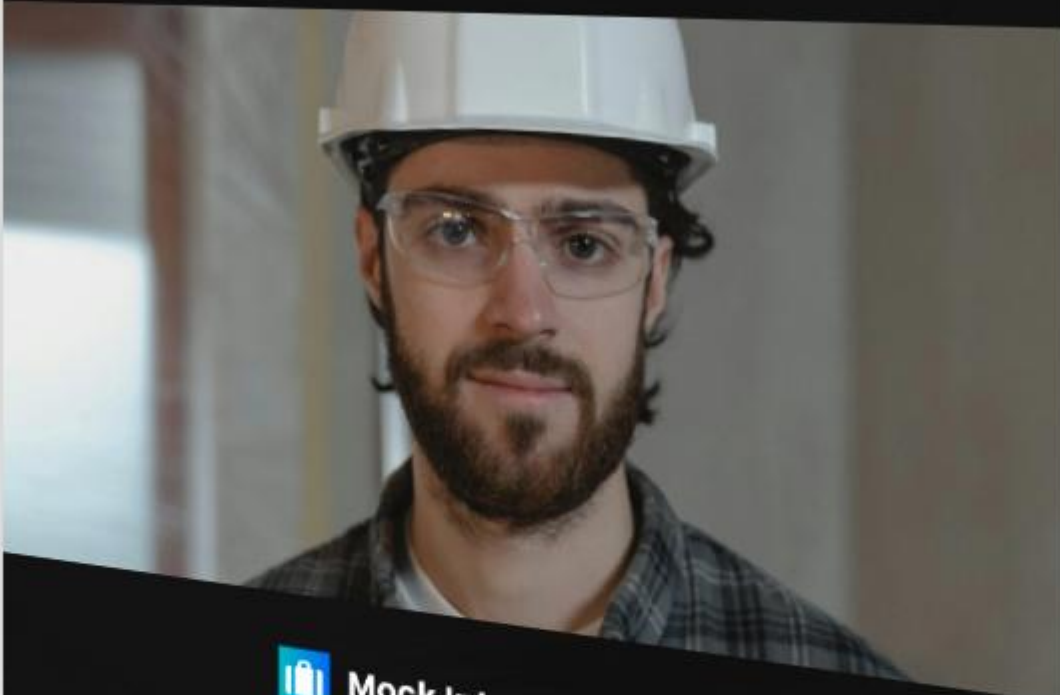
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How do you manage your time and prioritize tasks when juggling multiple vehicle repairs?
