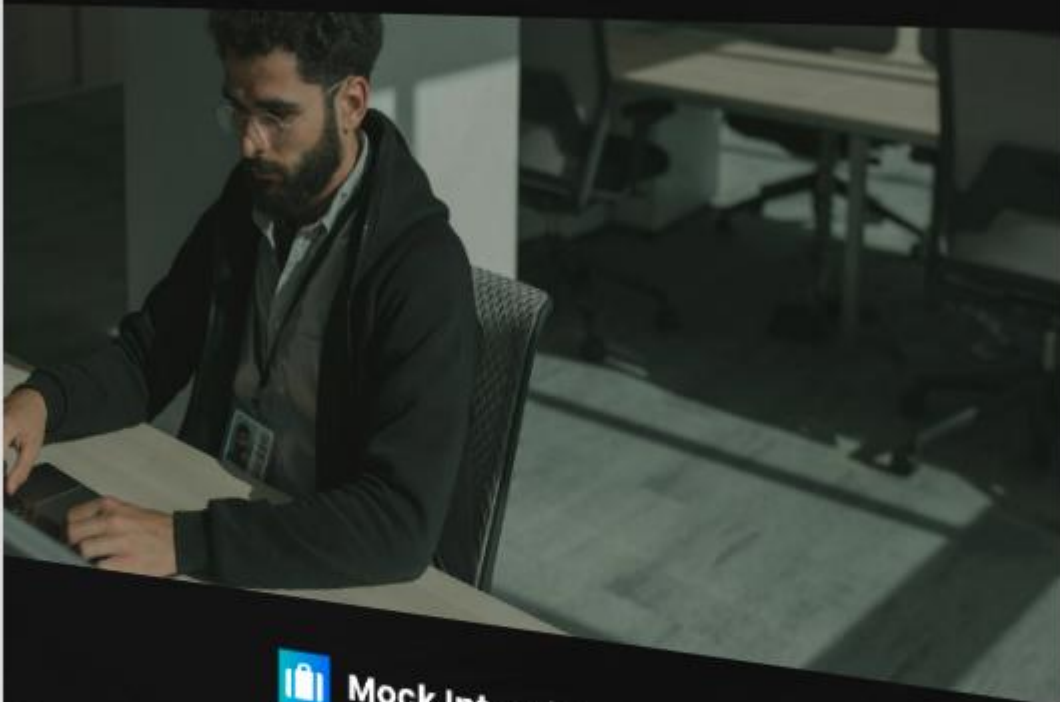

Enterprise Architect Job Title Summary

Job Description	An Enterprise Architect is responsible for aligning the business strategy with technology strategy. They are involved in all aspects of the organization's architecture including business processes, information, software, hardware, and IT infrastructure. They work closely with stakeholders to ensure that the IT infrastructure supports the organization's overall goals.
Skills	Knowledge of IT governance and operations, Comprehensive knowledge of hardware, software, application, and systems engineering, Knowledge of financial modeling as it pertains to IT investment, Interpersonal and leadership skills, Excellent communication and negotiation skills, Project and program management skills
Industry	Information Technology, Computer Software, Financial Services, Healthcare, Government, Retail
Experience Level	Senior-Level



Education Requirements	Bachelor's degree in Computer Science, Information Technology, or related field. Many positions also require a Master's degree in Business Administration (MBA) or a related field.
Work Environment	Enterprise Architects typically work in an office environment. They often work full time, but longer hours are common. They may need to be on call to handle issues that arise outside of normal business hours.
Salary Range	\$120,000 – \$180,000
Career Path	Enterprise Architects often start their career as a Software Developer or Network Administrator. They may then move into a role as a Systems Analyst or IT Project Manager before becoming an Enterprise Architect. After gaining experience as an Enterprise Architect, they may advance into roles such as Chief Technology Officer (CTO) or Chief Information Officer (CIO).

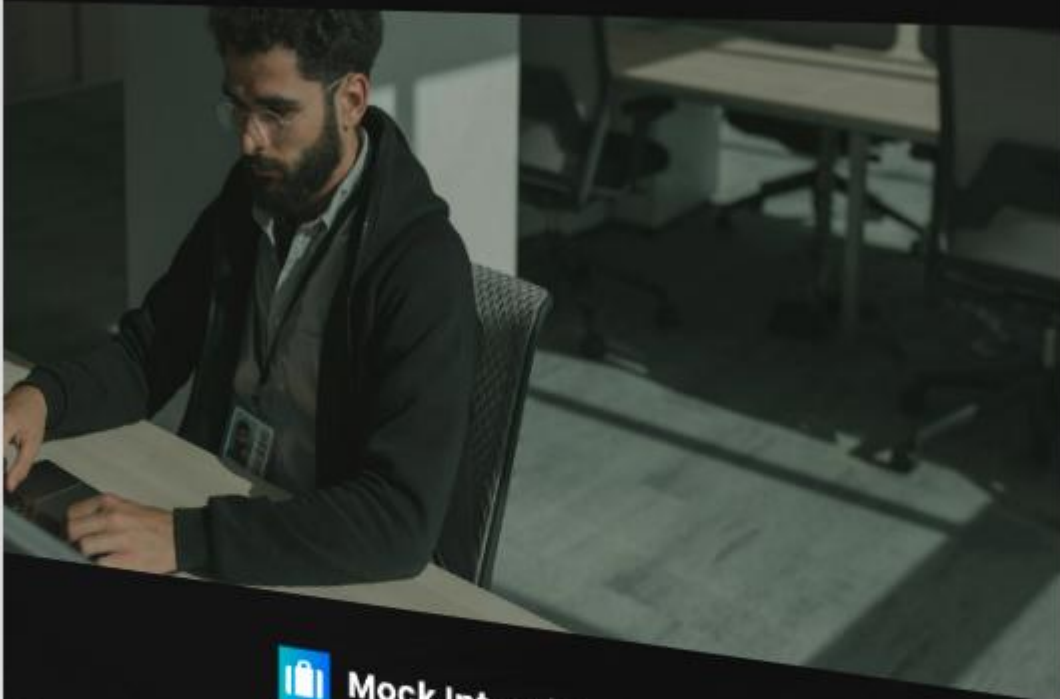
