They also provide technical support for both hardware and software issues that may arise.

Work Environment	System Administrators typically work in an office setting, though they may also work remotely. They often work regular business hours, but may need to be on-call or work outside of typical business hours for system upgrades or to handle issues.
Salary Range	\$50,000 to \$100,000 per year
Career Path	System Administrators can advance to roles such as IT Manager, IT Director, or Chief Technology Officer. They may also specialize in a specific area of IT, such as network administration or security, and advance within that specialty.

How to Answer:

The interviewer is looking for evidence of your problem-solving skills and technical competency. Begin by describing the situation in detail, then outline the steps you took to identify, diagnose, and resolve the issue. Be sure to highlight any tools or techniques you used. Finally, explain the outcome and any lessons you learned from the experience.

Example:

At my previous job, we experienced a sudden network slowdown that was affecting productivity. I started by isolating the issue, using network monitoring tools to check for unusual traffic or performance issues. I found that one of the switches was overloaded, causing a bottleneck. I redistributed the load to other switches and replaced the hardware. The issue was resolved, and I implemented regular performance checks to prevent a similar issue in the future.

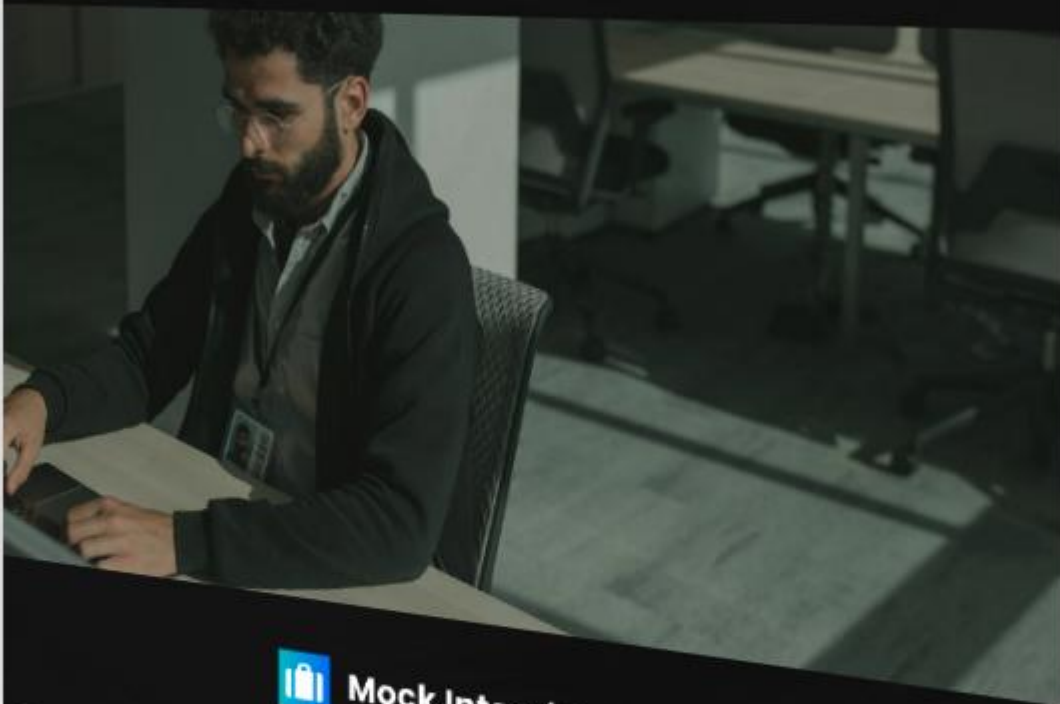
