Job Description	A truck driver is responsible for transporting goods from one location to another using heavy or tractor-trailer trucks. They are responsible for operating equipment such as electronic logging devices and maintaining detailed driving and delivery logs.
Skills	Commercial driving skills, Time management, Mechanical knowledge, Physical health and stamina, Customer service, Record keeping, Knowledge of safety regulations
